



C Level Player Expectations 2026 V2

Thank you for your valuable presence and expertise in the Maine Novice Hockey League.

Your contribution is essential to the league's success. You play a vital role in guiding developing players, maintaining game structure, and enhancing the overall experience for all participants. While you are not a dedicated coach, we encourage you to offer tips and guidance to other players as you see fit. To ensure a fair and enjoyable experience for everyone please adhere to the following expectations

1. Be a Mentor First

Your primary role is to elevate the players around you playing at their level.

- Teach positioning.
- Help direct breakouts.
- Encourage puck support.
- Give feedback on the bench.
- Celebrate beginner's improvements.

2. No End-to-End Rushes

To keep games competitive for lower level players:

- Do not carry the puck from your zone to the opposing net solo.
 - Move the puck early, get open, and let others develop the play.
- Use your IQ more than your speed.

3. Shooting/Scoring

To maintain fairness:

- Limit personal scoring to 1 MAX per game.
- Can not shoot during OT.
- You can only score when the game has a 2 goal differential.
- Focus on setups, cycling, and puck movement.

Your value isn't goals - it's teamwork and development.

No long-range shots from the blue line.

4. Maintain Composure and Sportsmanship

Beginner leagues can be chaotic.

- Avoid showing frustration on dead plays.

- Keep communication positive.
 - Help settle the bench when things get tense.
 - Lead by example with refs and opponents.
- Your presence helps maintain a safe, fun environment.*

5. Purpose of These Expectations

These guidelines ensure:

- Fair games.
- Player development.
- A positive atmosphere.
- Equal opportunity for all levels.
- A safe, enjoyable league for new players.

Your cooperation is appreciated and valued - the league only works when skilled players embrace the mentor role.

A truly skilled player doesn't just focus on dominating the game, they strive to elevate the performance of everyone around them. Your commitment to a positive attitude and strong leadership is essential in making the MNHL the most welcoming, supportive, and fun beginner league in Maine.

The MNHL is specifically structured for D/E level players and those who struggle on the lower end in the C leagues. For those seeking higher-skill competition, numerous alternative leagues are available in Maine. To maintain fair play, promote positive development, and ensure an enjoyable atmosphere for everyone, our more skilled players are **expected** to respect and adhere to the outlined guidelines.
